Looking ahead to 2023

It has been a busy fall for CodeSquad! We received over 170 inquiries about our program, a 12% increase over last year. Our competitive admissions process includes a written application, 3-week Mini Course, and live interviews, and ultimately 20 students were admitted to our 2023 Cohort. Students started self-paced intro classes this week, and begin live classes in January.

We've also hired new staff. New hires include Lead Teaching Fellow Yusuf Alp and Teaching Fellows Kit Amreik, Danielle Petrides, and Mariessa DeVincentis - all 2022 CodeSquad graduates – who join Sonia Paulino, Izebel Raab, and Executive Director Andrew Ott.
